Reading Genesis 3 Attentive to Human Evolution

Dr. J. Richard Middleton is Professor of Biblical Worldview and Exegesis at Northeastern Seminary and before that taught for ten years at Roberts Wesleyan College. His most recent book, *A New Heaven and a New Earth: Reclaiming Biblical Eschatology* will be published by Baker Academic in November. For the past year and a half, Dr. Middleton has been working as part of an interdisciplinary research team on the topic of human evolution and the Christian doctrine of the fall, co-sponsored by the Colossian Forum and the BioLogos Foundation.

Dr. Middleton's presentation will address the pressing question of how orthodox Christians might relate the biblical account of the origin of human sin in Genesis 3 to what paleo-anthropology and genetics seem to be telling us about the evolution of *Homo sapiens*. The presentation will explore alternatives to denying science, naively trying to harmonize the Bible and science, and keeping them totally apart in watertight compartments.
